The Nurse Practitioner Healthcare Foundation is proud to announce the 2016 NPHF/Astellas “Promoting Heart Health Across the Age Span” Award Program. This program provides five (5) awards of \$4000 each to Nurse Practitioner graduate students, faculty or practicing Nurse Practitioners with a clinical, research, or educational project on promoting heart health in children, adults or older adults in the United States. **The application postmark deadline has been extended to April 4, 2016 and winners will be notified by May 16, 2016.** Winners will receive an initial award of \$3000 to be used for project development and implementation and an additional \$1000 upon project completion for dissemination of outcomes through podium and/or poster presentation, journal article, etc. A Progress Report will be required by December 20, 2016 and the project must be completed by June 30, 2017.
